All curriculum pilot programs shall be approved by the Board. Such procedures shall Provide opportunities for input by citizens and staff Protect staff and students from harassment Require reasoned judgment in decision making Employee Expressions of Views In situations in which employees are not engaged in the performance of professional duties, they shall state clearly that their views are personal and do not reflect those of the District. Employees shall not direct expressions toward individuals they would normally be in contact with in the performance of duties to avoid disruption of cooperative staff relationships. Employees shall refrain from expressions that would interfere with the maintenance of discipline or that they know to be false. Employees shall not make threats against co-workers, supervisors, or District officials.
