Policy Statement	<ul> <li>Animals may not be brought into the school by anyone without the permission of the principal.</li> <li>If students wish to bring animals to class for educational purposes, they shall consult with their teacher who shall request permission from the principal.</li> <li>Animals are not to be transported by school bus without prior permission from the principal.</li> <li>A valid rabies certificate is required for any dog or cat six months or older brought into the classroom.</li> <li>Inherently dangerous animals and wild animals (e.g., squirrels, raccoons) may not be brought into schools.</li> <li>Animals must be adequately housed and cared for in appropriate cages. Only the teacher or students designated by the teacher may handle animals.</li> <li>Arrangements must be made for the care of animals on days that schools are not in session.</li> </ul>
