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INTRODUCTION

The Red Clay Community Financial Review Committee (CFRC) held its most recent meeting on Monday, January 12th in the cafeteria at Baltz Elementary School. A presentation on the FY09 final budget and subsequent questions occupied most of meeting, but time was also allocated for reviewing the regular monthly financial reports created by the District.

Absent from the meeting that night were committee members Larry Miller, Jane Rattenni, and Doug Suiter.

OLD BUSINESS

December's meeting minutes were approved, but a few revisions were requested. Once the final document is ready it will be emailed to the school board and posted on our website.

Final plans were put in place and commitments from committee members were solicited for our upcoming appearance at the January 29th taping of the television show *This Week in Red Clay*.

FY09 FINAL BUDGET PRESENTATION

Finance Director Jill Floore made a presentation to the committee on the FY09 final budget that was similar in content to what was given at the December school board meeting. Revenue and expenditure projections have decreased from what was proposed in the FY09 preliminary budget. The primary reason for the change was based on an analysis conducted by the Business Office, which concluded that state and local salary obligations would be less than originally projected.

MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT REVIEW

We have just passed the halfway point in the fiscal year and after the budget presentation the committee reviewed the two monthly financial documents that we study at every meeting. The reports were for the period ending December 31, 2008, and are the:

- Monthly Expenditure Report based on a DOE template and is broken out by schools, programs, departments, etc.
- YTD Total Expenditures and Encumbrances Report comes in two versions (with and without prior year appropriations) and looks at expenses by line item.

December 31st Expenditure Report Highlights

- The goal for revenue collection is still 100%, and to date 82.28% has been collected
- Budget targets should be at, or near 50% expended
 - Division 32 (General Operating Budget) is at 41.6% expended
 - Division 54 (Meadowood School) is at 43.6% expended
 - Division 58 (Intensive Learning Centers) is at 42.1% expended
