District still planning to contract with an independent consultant to review ESCO modeling to ensure project assumptions and guarantees are on track. District is working with DSEU (Delaware Sustainable Energy Utility) to leverage lower interest rates to refinance our existing lease for the energy improvements we made in 2013. We would not extend the term but may be approximately 70K a year in savings.
