## **Block Scheduling**

Conrad utilizes an A/B block schedule to maximize learning. Students have four 80 minute block periods between 7:25 am and 2:10 pm.

English Language Arts & Math are scheduled every day, effectively doubling the instruction students receive in these key subjects. This allows students to complete high school Algebra I & Geometry during middle school years.

Social Studies, Science, and exploratory arts classes rotate on an A day / B day schedule. The 80 minute block allows all classes to delve more deeply into subject area content, and there are fewer class changes daily.
