Student Outcome Goal 1

Student achievement on state assessments in all subjects in Domain 1 will increase from 46 to 58 by June 2025.

Student Outcome Goal 2

Student achievement on the third-grade state assessment in reading at the Meets performance level or above shall increase from 40.2% to 56.0% by June 2025

Student Outcome Goal 3

Student achievement on the third-grade state assessment in mathematics at the Meets performance level or above shall increase from 42.3% to 56.0% by June 2025

Student Outcome Goal 4

Middle-grade (grades 6-8) student achievement on state assessments in all subjects in Domain 1 will increase from 40 to 50 by June 2025
