Dear Parents,

The Uwchlan Hills Home & School Association (UHHSA) is a non-profit organization serving the students, faculty, staff, and community of our elementary school. We are very fortunate to have an amazing school community and pride ourselves on the incredible support we receive each year.

The intent of this letter is to explain the purpose of and to ask you to make a \$60 per family donation to UHHSA by November 29, 2024.

One of the functions of Home and School is to raise money for Uwchlan Hills. The money raised pays for a variety of programs and events enhancing your child's educational experience. These programs include: school assemblies, field trip transportation, field-day t-shirts, and classroom supplies above and beyond what the Downingtown Area School District provides. **100% of the money raised by UHHSA goes back into the school, benefiting all the students.**

Historically, UHHSA raised money through traditional fundraising type events (bake sale, carwash, wrapping paper sales, etc). However, our UH community decided to donate \$60 directly to the UHHSA rather than purchase over hundreds of dollars in products throughout the school year. Not only does this free up student, parent, and teacher time, but it also decreases the amount of mail going home with students.

Normally, our biggest fundraising event is the Fall Jamboree and all our other events make a small profit or break even—the main purpose being to bring Uwchlan Hills families and students together for fun.

We thank you in advance for supporting the UHHSA, and we look forward to the challenge of serving our Unicorn community in new and creative ways. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact any member of the board.

Uwchlan Hills Variety Show 2025

Hello Unicorns!

We are excited to announce that the Variety Show will be:

Monday, February 24st, 6:30 pm on the Uwchlan Hills Stage!

The Variety Show is traditionally a two act show of students performing individual or group acts. There are 5th Grade student emcees and a "bake sale" during intermission. The last number of the show is the 5th Grade Finale and is a slide show, song, and dance combination. The Variety Show is a fun opportunity for the students to perform on stage. Students, depending on age and experience, plan their music, costumes, dance moves, dialogue, jokes, routines, and staging etc., with or without parental support. The Permission Slip page should be filled out by a parent or guardian since it requires a signature. It is our job to organize the event, guide the students in presenting their talents, and organize the finale. This year's show is in February, so please take close note of the due dates.

Variety Show Fast Facts

- K-5 students can sing, dance, act, cheer, play an instrument solo or in a band. A student can demonstrate gymnastics, karate or any skill. He or she can perform magic tricks, comedy or entertain in another way.
- Any student may do a "Solo Act" or a "Group Act", but can only participate in one.
- Acts will be limited to 2 minutes.
- 4. If you require recorded musical accompaniment, please send the "2 minute long cut" to the email provided below by December 5th. Be sure to include in your email the name of the student(s) and act.
- Lyrics and dialogue must be appropriate for a K-5 audience and must be submitted no later than December 5th at the email provided below.
- Please fill out the permission slip completely. We will limit the number of times a song is repeated, so please get your form in as soon as possible to "reserve" your song.
- 7. The Permission Slip is due no later than Tuesday, November 12th.
- 5th Graders can additionally try out to be an Emcee (host) and/or participate in the 5th Grade Finale. This is a fun opportunity, but one requiring commitment and extra rehearsals.
 These positions require more responsibility and you will be expected to stay for the entire rehearsal for extra rehearsals.
- 9. 5th graders who do not want to perform, but would like to be involved behind the scenes can sign up to be on tech crew, work on the scripts, decorations and art, or the program for the show. It is difficult to be on the tech crew and perform in the show.
- 10. The "Permission Slip" can either be printed at home and sent to the school office in an envelope labeled "Variety Show", or email us and we will send a hard copy home with your student/group to fill out.
