# How does Trojan Nite Scoring work?

Each judge scores the grades in the respective categories. Categories can be worth a range of 5 points to 20 points depending on their "importance." For instance, the float category is worth 20 points while the t-shirt category is worth 10. Each judge gives a score and those scores are averaged. Below are the average scores for each grade in each category as well as the overall score for each grade (not including deductions).
