

NEW 24-25 SY ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL ROUTES FOR JOHNSON FAMILIES



Dear Johnson Families,

We want to inform you about the new arrival and dismissal procedures for the upcoming school year. Please review the details below:

Bus Riders:

- Buses will unload and load students on Gilpin Avenue, directly in front of the school.
- Families are no longer drive down Gilpin Avenue during arrival and dismissal times unless arrival has ended.
- Students are considered tardy after 9:05 AM and must enter the school via Gilpin Avenue with an adult.

Car Riders:

- Arrival begins at 8:45 am. Car riders can begin to line up no earlier than 8:40 am for arrival and 3:40 pm for dismissal. Families should approach the school starting from Pennsylvania Avenue and traveling onto North Bancroft Parkway. Please do not enter the car line from the neighborhood of 14th, 16th, and 17th streets. Families will be rerouted to Pennsylvania Avenue.

- Cars must park on the right-hand side of N. Bancroft Parkway to allow traffic to pass.
- At the corner of N. Bancroft Parkway and Delaware Avenue, a staff member will direct cars to proceed when it is safe.
- A designated number of cars will be allowed to pull up to the corner of Gilpin Avenue and N. Bancroft Parkway to drop off students. Staff members will assist with guiding students to the school entrance. Family members are to remain in the car.

Important Reminders:

- Please stay in your car during arrival and dismissal to ensure a quick and smooth process.
- Do not block neighborhood driveways or passing streets. The Wilmington Police Department will enforce traffic regulations.

Car Tags:

- Car tags will be provided by the school and must be visible in the front window for staff to see.
- These tags will help us identify students for prompt dismissal.
- Please make sure your child knows their car tag number.
- If you do not pick up the car tag on Meet the Teacher Night, it will be sent home with your child during the first week of school.

Using the car tag permits the listed family member to pick up your child from school.
