

- Screening is a quick check of how your child is growing, developing, and learning.
- 1 Hour Appointment includes: hearing and vision checks as well as developmental games with one of our EC teachers.
- These developmental activities change based on the age of the child.
- Children may be screened between
   3 years old and the start of kindergarten.
- All children in the State of MN are required to participate in early childhood screening, free of charge. Screening appointments are designed to connect children with further educational or health resources that may be needed.
