Subject: School Year 2022–2023 (Fiscal Year 2023) Local Educational Agency
Approved Indirect Cost Rates

To the Administrator Addressed:

TEA's Federal Fiscal Compliance and Reporting (FFCR) Division reviews, approves, and negotiates indirect cost rates for local educational agencies (LEAs). The approved indirect cost rate allows the LEA to recover indirect costs incurred in the administration of federal grants.

As the cognizant agency for your LEA, TEA has approved your restricted and unrestricted indirect cost rates for school year 2022–2023. The restricted rate is used for grant programs covered by a supplement, not supplant provision. The unrestricted rate is used for grant programs without such a provision. (You can find detailed information on the supplement, not supplant provision in the [Supplement, Not Supplant Handbook](#), posted in the "Related Content" section of the [ESSA Program Compliance](#) page of our website.)

The following rates for school year 2022–2023 are effective July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023:

Unrestricted Indirect Cost Rate	14.718%

2022–2023 Indirect Cost Rates

The Federal Fiscal Compliance and Reporting (FFCR) Division has published indirect cost rates for independent school districts and open-enrollment charter schools. These rates are effective July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

You may find your indirect cost rates in either of two places:

- The [Indirect Cost Rates](#) page of the TEA website lists 2022–2023 indirect cost rates for all independent school districts and open-enrollment charter schools.
- The GFFC Reports and Data Collections secure TEAL application includes a 2022–2023 Indirect Cost Rate Notification Letter for each independent school

district and open-enrollment charter school. Follow these steps to access your letter:

1. Log on to [TEAL](#).
2. Select “GFFC Reports and Data Collections.”
3. Select “View Reports and ISD Responses.”
4. Select “Notification Letter – Indirect Cost Rate” from the Report Title drop-down menu.
5. Select “2022–2023” from the School Year drop-down menu.
