  - 4. <u>EDI Walk Through Results</u>. Baseline data was provided to indicate the effectiveness of programs--where we're at and where we need to go.

  - HHS Principal Cris Oseguera reported on a strong semester. Foreign Language teacher, Betty Mercado, reported on her classes including the challenge of AP Spanish's technology portion, her desire to expand the department to include Spanish three, and the exemption process.
