Winter Sports will begin soonget cleared to practice now

If you are not participating in a Fall sport, and are interested in playing a Winter sport, it is important to start the sports clearance process now. You will need 1. a current physical exam completed by a doctor; 2. an online profile in "Athletic Clearance"; 3. be academically eligible with at least a 2.0 GPA; 4. be on track to graduate at Hamilton High (not deficient in credits as determined by school admin).

Please ask your Principal, your Athletic Director, or our office staff for more information on how get cleared to participate. This information is also available online at the HHS website under the "Athletics" tab then the "Sports Eligibility & Physicals" in the drop down menu.

The counseling department would like to make you aware of important upcoming dates and events for 12th grade students. First, Wednesday October 12, we will be hosting a Financial Aid workshop in the HHS library at 6pm for parents and students. Our counselors will be available to assist with the FAFSA form and requirements that evening and are also able to help by appointment at other times.

We are also leading a Campus Tour on October 24-25 to Monterey Bay State University, Monterey Peninsula College, UC Santa Cruz, and Cabrillo College.

Also, below are links to the following websites for college applications. Our counselors can assist with the general components of the applications, but we cannot complete or fill our for the applying students.

- **1. California State University Application**: Filing period for all CSU campuses is from October 1 to **November 20, 2022**. The preferred method of application is online at Cal State Apply: https://www2.calstate.edu/apply
- **2. University of California Application**: Filing period for all UC campuses is from November 1 to **November 30, 2022**. Students can start their application online at www.universityofcalifornia.edu
- **3. Common Application**: Many out-of-state and private colleges use the Common Application. This application is available online at www.commonapp.org
- **4. Local Scholarships**: all local scholarships, along with statewide and national scholarships, are located on the HHS webpage counseling tab as well as in the counselors' office.
- 5. FAFSA: This is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. Students submit the FAFSA to apply for financial aid for college from the federal government, state governments, and most colleges and universities. Financial aid includes grants, scholarships, student employment, and student loans. The FAFSA opens October 1, 2022. For students to be considered for Cal Grants, they must complete and submit their FAFSA by March 2, 2023.
- **6. Butte College Promise Grant** (2 years FREE): This grant offers students the opportunity of up to two years free from enrollment fees for new, first-time Butte College students. The Promise Grant does require that the student complete and submit their FAFSA (or CADAA for Dream Act students) to be eligible. The Promise Grant is not based on income.

If you don't have every one of these documents, that's okay. Come to a workshop with the documents that you have and that apply to you.

- Driver's license, if you have one
- Social Security card or number, if you have one
- Alien registration number, if you have one
- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) yours or your parents'
- Your tax and parent tax information for 2021
- 2021 bank statements
- Any records of untaxed income such as welfare benefits, Social Security benefits, or child support payments
- List of colleges you are interested in attending
