## Hamilton High School HUSD Board Report June 2022

- 1. Congratulations to the Class of 2022! An excellent well-attended ceremony was held on Friday June 3. Seventy-seven total students graduated this school year, with one student now pending. (For HHS, 73 graduates and for Ella Barkley, 4 graduates). The Valedictorians was Aaron Boone; the Salutatorians were Annie Belter, Joseph Carlos, and Riley Stickney. It was great to be able to lead the ceremony after many months in recovery and I am thankful to the community for their support of our students and staff!
- 2. Enrollment: 2022-23 Projected/tentative for HHS Grades 9-12= 298; EBHS=5. Total 9-12= 303 students. Numbers subject to change. 9<sup>th</sup> Grade=87.
- 3. <u>Summer School</u>: We are currently serving approximately 35 students until June 30. Summer School began on June 12 and runs from 8-12pm each day. We are fortunate to have two teachers again this summer school which allows us to serve a greater number of students. All summer school work is for credit recovery purposes.
- 4. <u>Summer Activities</u>: Through GEAR UP grant funding, about 16 HHS students were able to participate in college visitation to Cal Poly Humboldt and Southern Oregon University last week. This is part of our goal to enrich our students with opportunities for exploration of different colleges and universities throughout the region. These will continue during the 2022-23 school year.
- 5. <u>Summer Athletic Workouts</u>: Various workouts are occurring and planned throughout the summer as we prepare for the official practices on August 1. We are also fortunate to have two parents/physicians volunteer their time to offer sports physicals for our student-athletes! Thank you Dr. Stickney and Dr. Matthews!
