## CAASPP State Testing for 11th and 12th in April & May at HHS

This spring, we will be administering the California Assessment of Student Progress and Performance (CAASPP) test. All high schools with eligible students grades 11 or 12 will administer the CAASPP test. Each school and district will receive student scores for the test and student participation data will be collected and reported for accountability.

For Hamilton High, our test window will be open from late March through late May. We will coordinate the testing schedule to offer the students the best opportunity for success. We ask that parents continue to encourage their student to get appropriate rest, eat healthy, and enter with a positive attitude ready for success!

As a reminder, our students in grade 11 will be taking the CAASPP test for English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science. Our 12th graders will be taking the Science test. For more information on testing schedules, please contact your child's school site test coordinator, Mr. Oseguera.

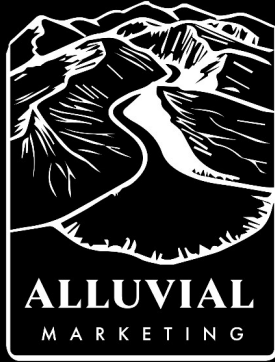
