

Table 1: Students Who Test Positive for COVID-19

<p>Requirements apply to all students regardless of vaccination status, previous infection, or lack of symptoms.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stay home if you have COVID-19 symptoms. Student may return to school once they are fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicine AND other COVID symptoms are mild and improving. 2. COVID-19 without symptoms, follow #3 masking recommendation while at school. If they develop symptoms, follow #1 3. Mask, strongly recommended for the remainder of the 10 days from symptom onset or positive test if symptom free. Student may test out of masking with 2 sequential negative tests at least one day apart. 4. Negative test is NOT required to return to school. <p>*The potential infectious period is 2 days before the date symptoms began or the positive test date (if no symptoms) through Day 10. (Day 0 is the symptom onset date or positive test date).</p>
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Table 2: Student Close Contact

<p>Asymptomatic Persons Who are Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (No Quarantine)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If new COVID-19 symptoms develop, the student should be sent home to test and mask right away. If student refuses to test they should stay home until fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medicine AND other COVID symptoms are mild and improving. 2. No symptoms, and are at higher risk of severe COVID-19 infection and would benefit from treatment, the student should test within 5 days. 3. Mask; recommended for 10 days following last known contact.
