DROP OFF

Drop off is at **Driveway B** (first right on Polk Township).

Cars should line up along the sidewalk and park as directed. Children must exit *curbside* by 8:45 AM and enter the building promptly.

After 8:55 AM, students must be signed in at the *main* office by a guardian.

PARENT PICK-UP

Whether picking up **daily**, **weekly**, **or occasionally**, you must register through the **application**.

Any changes to pick-up schedules must be emailed to pviparentpickup@pvbears.org by 2 PM.

Pick-up is at Driveway B (first right on Polk Township), where cars must line up along the sidewalk and park as directed. **All cars need a pick-up tag**; without one, you'll need to sign out your child with ID at the main office.
