

Disable Parent and Student Access - District

This document outlines steps to disable the Parent/Student Portal. Disabling the Parent/Student Portal is useful once schedules have been committed for a future year. Student schedules are available to view on the Parent/Student Portal at any time when the Portal is enabled. This guide will assist you in completing the necessary tasks.

Overview

This process will disable access via the Portal and Mobile Apps:

- Step 1: Steps will be completed in the District Office
 - Step 2: Navigate to District Additional System Preferences
 - Step 3: Disable Student and Parent Portals/Mobile Apps
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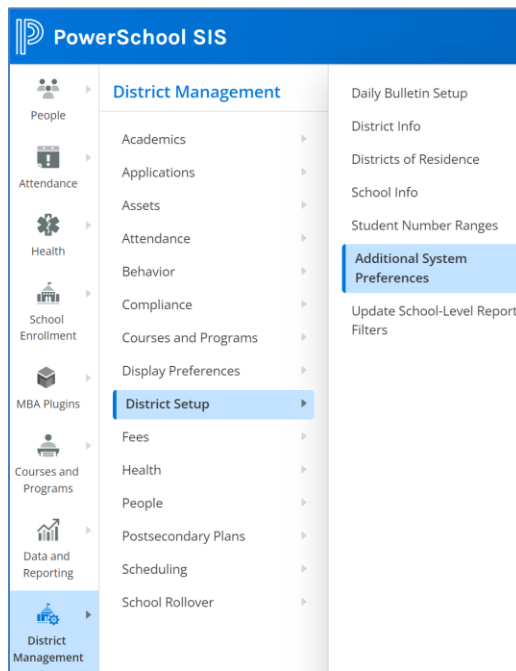
Disable Parent and Student Access

1. Select School

- Use the **DROP-DOWN MENU** (top right of PS Start Page) to choose DISTRICT OFFICE

2. Navigation Steps

- Select **DISTRICT MANAGEMENT** on left navigation pane
- Select **DISTRICT SETUP** from the pop out drawer
- Choose **ADDITIONAL SYSTEM PREFERENCES**



3. Additional System Preferences

- Check **DISABLE STUDENT AND PARENT PORTALS/MOBILE APPS**
- Create a **MESSAGE TO STUDENTS AND PARENTS**
- Submit
