With a population of approximately 1,200 students in grades nine through twelve, the high school provides a comprehensive curriculum with a variety of electives aimed to promote the development of each student's individual potential.

North Plainfield High School is a National School of Character and has been named to the Gaston Caperton Opportunity Honor Roll and the AP Honor Roll.

### Curriculum

High school students may select courses that suit both their interests and potential career paths. Honors, advanced placement courses are available for those students who meet the criteria. Electives are offered in art, music, theater, technology, journalism, world language, and family consumer science. Career and technical education programs of study include Cisco, Project Lead the Way-Biomedical & Engineering, Work Based Learning -Internship Program, and Navy Junior ROTC. Other curricular options include opportunities for independent study, community service, distance learning, and a shared-time vocational program with Somerset County Vocational and Technical High School. Students that meet requirements can obtain college credits with the Concurrent Enrollment Program through our partnership with Raritan Valley Community College.

## Grading System, Rank & Scale

Advanced Placement, college preparatory, and honors level courses are weighted. College Preparatory Courses are given an additional weight of 1 point and Advance Placement & Honors courses receive an additional two points calculated in their final grade and Grade Point Average. Ranking occurs at the end of four, six and seven semesters.
