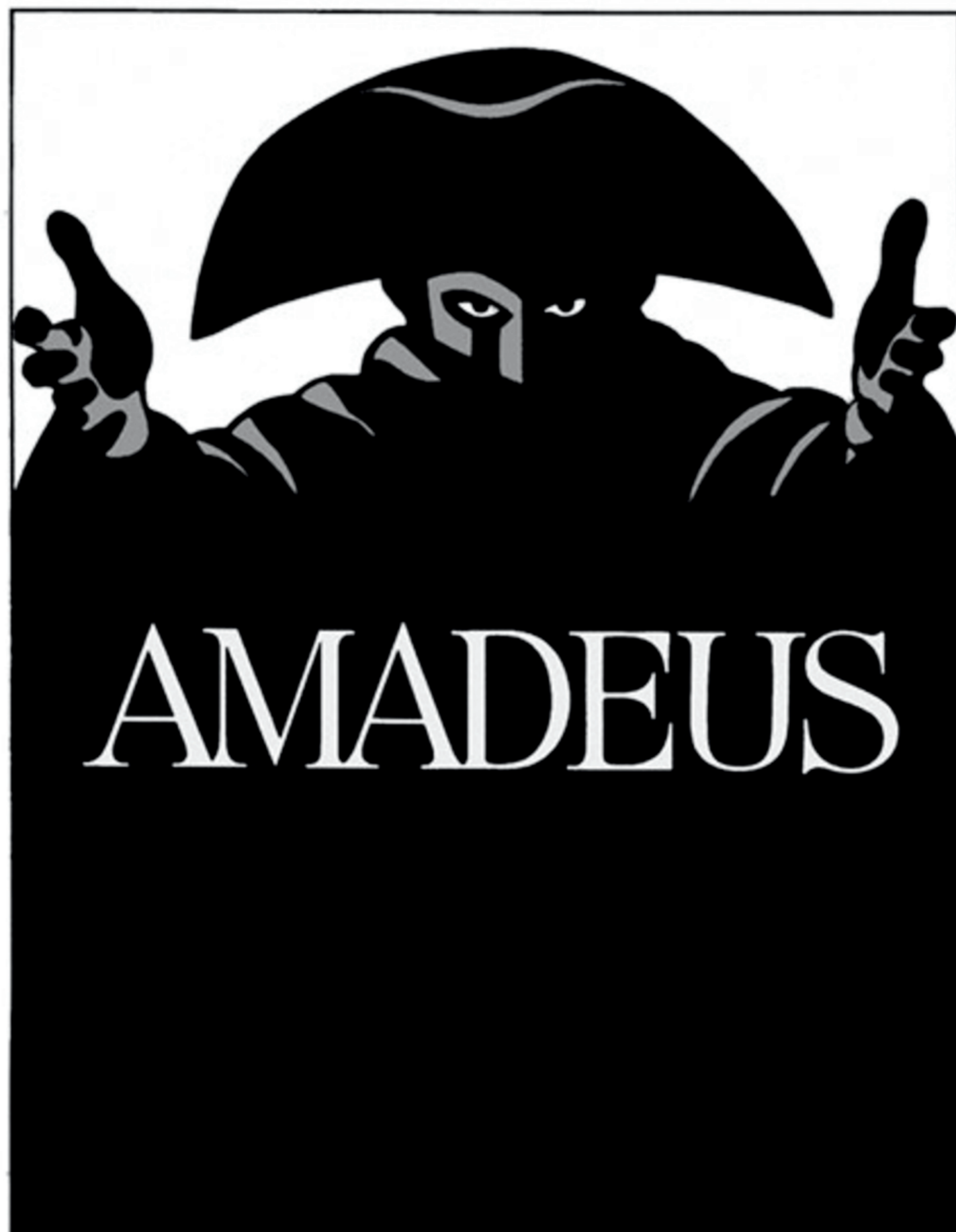

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Good evening, and welcome to the 2024 CHS Fall Play!

As a theatre department, it is always our goal to present pieces that challenge both our actors and audience. There is no question that *Amadeus* sets a high bar for our cast. I saw *Amadeus* on Broadway the year after it won five Tony awards. In 1984, a film adaptation directed by Milós Forman won eight Academy Awards and brought *Amadeus* to a wider public. Since then, Peter Shaffer has re-written the play several times. It's important to remember that Shaffer's work is historical fiction. Salieri and Mozart did cross paths in late 1700s Vienna, and their interactions were not always cordial, but there is no evidence that Salieri brought Mozart's life to an early, untimely end.

For our actors, the script is challenging in a number of ways. Like *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time*, *Amadeus* is a long script. And like last year's show, one character is on stage for virtually the entire performance. That's a huge challenge for any actor. Not to mention, we've had to master French and Italian along the way. The timeframe is also different for our students. We've become experts in opera, the 18th Century Hapsburg Empire, and billiards. The cast has worked tirelessly to surmount these challenges, and the outcome speaks for itself. It leaves me speechless each time I watch them work.

I also want to take a quick moment to address some of the language in *Amadeus*. When I saw it last spring in Cleveland, Outcalt Theatre had a sign advising, "mild profanity and innuendo." We've cut some language, but we've chosen to retain some as well. It's integral to the plot. Salieri has to be appalled by Mozart's language and behavior. Mozart's first language was German, and Peter Shaffer uses the Anglicization of traditional German "expressions." These "mild profanities" are not included in this evening's performance with any intention to offend but rather to provide crucial plot points throughout this evening's performance.

To the cast...thank you for your hard work, time, and dedication. I have had the opportunity to work with some of you previously and others are newcomers to our stage. Your time and effort has created a truly memorable theatrical moment, and I thank you for allowing me to share this journey with you!

SYNOPSIS

Peter Shaffer's *Amadeus* is a work of historical fiction. The play's inspiration is derived from several actual encounters between two composers, Antonio Salieri and Wolfgang Mozart, in the 1780s. It's a tale of music, malice and madness.

Amadeus opens in the dark streets of Vienna, Austria in 1823. Rumors are rampant that Antonio Salieri, former court composer to Emperor Joseph II, has confessed to murdering his once-rival, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. In a break with theatrical convention, Salieri summons the audience to his Vienna apartment to confess his monstrous crime—the destruction of his famed rival, Mozart.

Salieri transports the audience back in time to 1781, right before he and Mozart meet. Young Salieri is a devout Catholic who has vowed to dedicate his life to composing music in the name of God. He is a favorite of the Royal Court and feels comfortable in his job and reputation until he hears that Mozart has arrived in Vienna. Mozart's name is on everyone's lips, and Salieri becomes anxious to greet the young composer who has been a musical prodigy since childhood.

Salieri finally meets Mozart and, to his horror, Mozart turns out to be an infantine, immature, and vulgar young man. His music, though, is transcendent... its genius pierces the soul of Salieri who can't understand how this petulant young man received the musical gift that he has been working towards his whole life. As he reels from the beauty of Mozart's music, Salieri repudiates his deal with God and dedicates himself, instead, to ruining Mozart's career.

As Salieri's battle with God intensifies, he decides that he must destroy Mozart completely, all while hiding behind a mask of friendliness and concern for the young artist. As Salieri poisons Mozart's reputation at every turn, Mozart becomes increasingly isolated and desperate. But did Salieri actually kill one of the world's greatest composers??? The audience is left to ponder that question when the final curtain falls.

EMPEROR JOSEPH II **DAVID BROPHY**

The Emperor of Austria. His every opinion is supported and magnified by those around him. He is never challenged or questioned, but he is easily manipulated by Salieri.

BARON GOTTFRIED VAN SWIETEN **DALTON HUNT**

Austrian diplomat, librarian, and government official; enthusiastic amateur musician; patron of great composers; salieri's inner circle.

COUNTESS JOHANNA KILLIAN VON STRACK **AISHA GANGA**

A proper and stiff court official who serves as the Chamberlain of the Imperial Chamber; salieri's inner circle.

COUNTESS FRANCESCA ORSINI-ROSENBERG **MIA COLLINS**

Diplomat and politician; salieri's inner circle.

KATHERINA CAVALIERI / VENTICELLO 1 **ANGELINA FETTERLY**

Austrian Soprano; studied voice under Salieri; portrayed as Salieri's love interest; performed for mozart.

TERESA SALIERI / VENTICELLO 1 **AVERY COLLINS**

Salieri's respectable, quiet, polite, calm wife. A solemn woman, she supports her husband but does not understand his music or his ambition.
