

- Research what is required from you

College

- Start researching application requirements and deadlines ASAP!
- Common App



WHERE DO I GO NEXT?

Trade School

- Hands-on learning to prepare for a specific job/career
 - Examples: Electrician, carpenter, dental hygienist, phlebotomist, cosmetologist, chef, HVAC technician, mechanic

Unions/Apprenticeship Schools

- Paid on-the-job training & benefits
- Often times have a math & drug test associated with joining
 - Examples: Local 5 Ironworkers, Local 602 Steamfitters, Local 10 Ele

Military

- Meet with recruiter to see what is required
- Take the ASVAB


NEED HELP FIGURING OUT WHERE TO GO NEXT?

College Visits

- Representatives from many different colleges have set up times to meet – just with CHS students!
- This is a great opportunity to connect with admissions reps – these are the people who will most likely be reviewing your application!
- Sign up to attend complete the form by 12 PM the day before to participate in a college visit.
- On the day of the visit, you will receive a pass to attend.

- → Mrs. Kidwell is our CHS representative
- → Can help with anything college search, college applications, scholarships, FAFSA
- → Will be at CHS starting in late September
- → Can meet for group sessions during lunch or for individual sessions

SAT & ACT

- Scores should be ready to send out with your applications
- → If you feel that you may qualify for a fee waiver, please reach out to your counselor.
- → Next SAT deadline: September 20 for October test
 - → October 18 for November test
- → Next ACT deadline: September 20 for October test
 - → November 8 for December test
- → Many colleges have made SAT/ACT scores OPTIONAL, but you may still need it to be considered for scholarships. Check on this!
- → When sending scores, see how the college wants them self reported or sent directly from the testing agency!



LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- → Most college applications require AT LEAST one recommendation from a teacher, counselor or coach
 - → NOTE: CSM does NOT require letters of recommendation for admission

→ ASK EARLY!

- → Give your recommender time to give you their best recommendation
- → Use Request for Recommendation form
 - → Available on Schoology and will be emailed to you
 - → Can also download it: https://bit.ly/calvertdocrequests
 - → It's a Word document you can type right in the document, save it, and then email it to the person you are asking to write the letter

TRANSCRIPTS

- → Your transcript lists all the high school courses you have ever taken (including any middle school courses you took for high school credit, like Spanish, Intro to Engineering or Algebra 1/Geometry)
- → Includes FINAL end-of-year grades for each of your courses (not current or report card grades, although we will include a current copy of your senior year report card if you request after the first quarter)
- → Includes GPA and class rank



TRANSCRIPTS

- → Request your transcript from your counselor by using Transcript Request form (this is available on Schoology, online at bit.ly/calvertdocrequests and will also be emailed to you)
- → One form per college (unless you are using the Common App)
- → If transcript needs to be mailed, you will need to pick up your transcript from the CHS counseling office and mail it on your own.
- → BE MINDFUL OF DEADLINES!!
- → Request AT LEAST 10 school days before the deadline!



TRANSCRIPTS

→ Our transcript request form is a fillable PDF, so you can type right in the form, SAVE IT, and then email it to Mrs. Ponti PLEASE COMPLETE THIS FORM, SAVE IT, AND EMAIL IT TO YOUR COUNSELOR!

DEADLINES & REQUIREMENTS

- → Be aware of deadlines and expectations to be sure that you can turn in all required information on time!
- Colleges will NOT accept late applications!
- Get organized and know what is expected of you
- → You CAN turn in transcript requests and recommendations early!



SCHOLARSHIPS

- → FREE MONEY! (but you have to apply!)
- → View CCPS Scholarship List
 - https://bit.ly/ccpsscholarships
- → FAFSA (can fill out starting in December) to get money from your school

CSM PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

- → Scholarship of up to \$5,000 just for CSM
- → Income requirements; GPA minimum 2.3
- → Must complete FAFSA ASAP <u>after</u> <u>December</u> and send results to CSM
- → Also must complete application on MDCAPS account
- → Money is limited FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED!

- Common App
- Common Black College Application





COLLEGE APPLICATION FEES

- → Expect to pay anywhere from \$35 \$90 per college for application fee
- → Your counselor may also be able to help with application fee waivers if you are on free or reduced lunch or have extenuating financial circumstances at home
- See your counselor for directions on how to access these

REGISTERING WITH NCAA

→ If you plan to play a college sport at the Division 1 or Division 2 level, you will need to register with NCAA

- → Stay organized and know your deadlines! Stress can be avoided if you know what's expected of you by when. It's your responsibility (not your parent's or your counselor's!) to know what is required of you. Don't miss out!
- → **Follow up!** Some colleges will email you with additional instructions after you submit your application. Keep an eye out for this so you don't miss anything!

SENATE PAGE PROGRAM


- → Are you interested in government and politics?
