## St. Joseph's University On-site Criteria:

Typically, admitted students have a solid B average (mid 80s) and at least an 1100 SAT, or a 21 ACT (currently we are test optional). We do, however, review all application materials and are interested in students with leadership positions, school involvement, community service, a strong curriculum, and high regents scores.

We recommend the students fill out the online application which can be accessed through our website at: [www.sjny.edu/applynow](http://www.sjny.edu/applynow). Students can also apply on the Common App, but please apply a few days earlier since it takes longer for us to receive it. Please enter promo code **SJUNIVERSITY** on the payment page to have fee waived for on-site.

It is recommended that any students interested in our B.S, in Nursing apply early. Keep in mind, students applying to the Sciences or Nursing will have applications brought back for review.

Students will get an idea of a decision on the spot, but everything will be brought back to my director for final review. They will then be notified via email of their decision and scholarship awarded.

Beforehand, students should have:

- A completed application (on our website, or Common App)
- An official transcript (ask your counselor) \*Guidance office will provide
- A copy of standardized test scores printed from your on-line account (SAT/ACT) (Optional)
- A letter of recommendation, college essay, activities list or resume. \* Guidance office can provide the letter of recommendation

## LIU Post On-site Criteria:

- GPA: 82+ (85 for Nursing and Vet Tech Students)
  - If students are applying with an 80-81, they can be admitted with a 1050+ SAT or 20+ ACT
  - 80-81 no test scores will be waitlisted
- Test Optional but not test blind! I recommend all students applying (above 82 GPA), apply test optional and I will work with the students on whether they should send me their scores or not. I want to award them the highest scholarship right off the bat!
- Transcript is required, but essay and letters of recommendation are supplemental for the on-site.
- Application should be done 48 hours prior to the on-site. The application can be completed on the LIU website or through the Common Application. **The fee waiver code is LIU25.**

# Molloy University On-Site Admissions Information

Thank you for hosting a Molloy University On-Site Admissions event! We are excited to visit and speak with your students while celebrating their successes. On-Sites are meant to be positive and affirming events where students can see how their many achievements can result in admission to Molloy University.

Keeping the idea of this being a positive and affirming event, please see the following requirements:

1. **Application Deadline** – One (1) week prior to on-site appointment. Please have registered students apply a week before the on-site, students can be added after the initial list is sent but please keep the deadline in mind.
2. **Documents Required:**
  - Application (Common App or Molloy App)
  - Fee waiver code for \$45 application fee is “ONSITE”.
  - Essay (If they submitted the Common App or Molloy App)
  - High School Transcript
4. **GPA should be no less than 85 (3.0)\***
5. **Molloy is test optional.** If a student is going to submit test scores, they will only be used to help a student in the admissions process. Test scores can also help determine eligibility for merit aid. SATs should be no less than 1000 combined on the SAT (ACT Composite Score of 20 or higher).
6. **Students applying to the Nursing Program may sit for the On-Site.** If the student meets the requirements for the Nursing program, they will be admitted directly into the Nursing program.
  - Students that are interested in nursing should have an **87\* or above GPA.**
  - If they are submitting test scores, they should have at least a SAT score of 1050 (ACT 22).
7. **Appointment slots should be 10 minutes long**, but a representative will be able to meet with a student if they have additional questions or concerns.

*\* If a student doesn't meet requirements, please do not encourage them to attend the on-site. Instead, you could recommend that they attend to speak with a counselor about their options.*

Please note the following:

- Letters of Recommendation are NOT required, but if the student has them, we recommend they submit them.
- Students applying to the CAP21 Musical Theatre or Music programs will not receive a decision until after their audition- they are welcome to come and meet with us, but we are unable to give them a decision.

**SAT/ACT Range\*: 1080 SAT or 21 ACT**

\*Please note FSC is SAT/ACT optional for the Fall 2025 year. Students do not need to submit, this is a guideline should they wish to.

**Programs excluded from Onsite:** Professional Pilot, Dental Hygiene, Educational Opportunity Program (EOP), Interaction Design, Nursing, Visual Communications.

**Application Fee\*: \$50**

**SUNY Free Application Week: October 21- November 3**

\*Please note: As a member of the State University of New York, Farmingdale State College cannot waive the application fees outside of this period. All fee waivers must be submitted independently through SUNY or Common App. SUNY Processing: 1-800-342-3811

**Optional Documents to submit:** Essay/Personal Statement, Teacher Recommendation, Counselor Recommendation, and Activity Sheet/Resume
