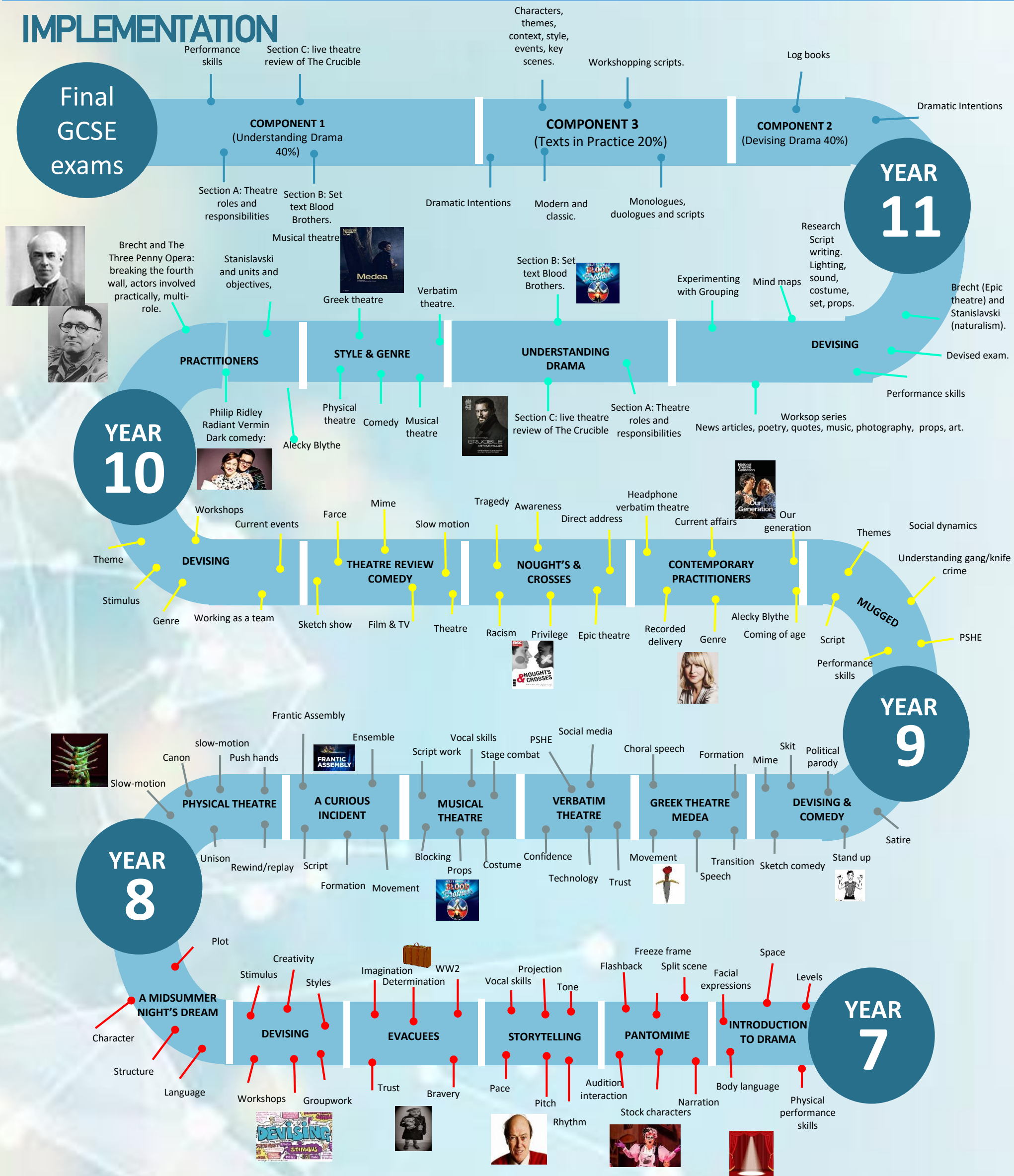


INTENT
