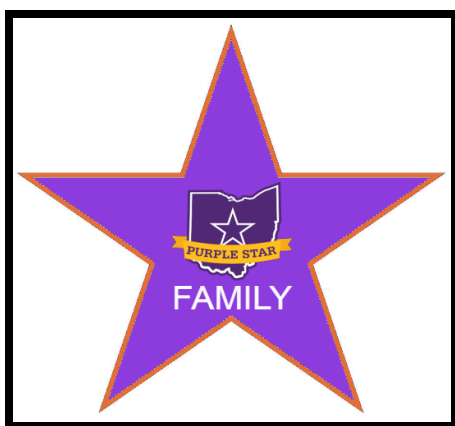
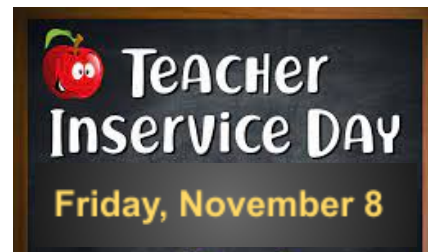

Nov. 8: NO SCHOOL for Students TOMORROW!

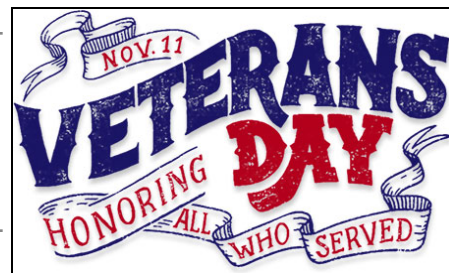
There will be **NO SCHOOL** for students on **Friday, November 8, 2024** due to scheduled teacher in-service & teacher professional development day.

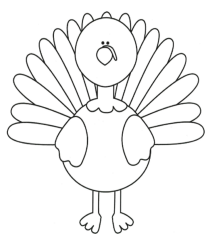


Nov. 11: PTO Stem Night! 6:30-7:30 p.m.

COOLER WEATHER REMINDER:

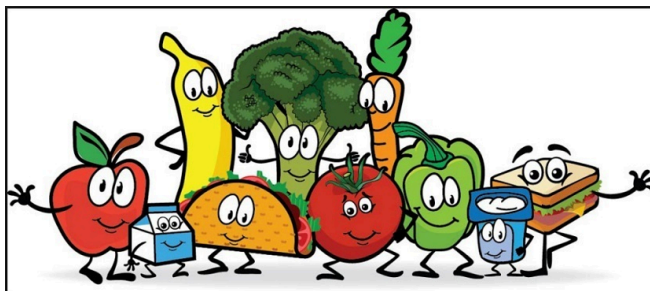
