Performance Objective 2: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, gifted students (GT) will improve their performance from 54% to 65% at the Master's level on all STAAR assessments in grades 3rd-5th.

Performance Objective 3: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, 85% of Kindergarten through 2nd-grade students will achieve benchmark or higher in reading, as measured by the mClass assessment.

Performance Objective 4: By end of 2024-25 school year, the percent of 3rd-5th grade students achieving "meets grade level" or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 35% to 50%.
