#### Hope Squad

Hope Squad is a school-based peer support team, made up of students who are nominated by their peers, that partners with local mental health agencies. Research shows that children and young adults who are contemplating suicide are more likely to reach out to their peers than the adults in their lives. In this way, Hope Squad members are the "eyes and ears" of the school building – monitoring for warning signs of suicide and helping to connect their peers with staff members who can offer the appropriate resources in times of need. The Unified School District of De Pere has Hope Squad teams at Foxview, DPMS, and DPHS.

Teens can obtain a permit in WI at age 15.

- Teens will not be allowed to apply for their probationary license until they are at least 16 years old, hold their permit for at least 6 months ticket free, practice hours of at least 50 hours and 10 of those at night, and have completed all of driver education (classroom and BTW lessons).
- Another change is that the **permit will be good for 18 months** instead of 12 months. All 16-17 year olds **will have to take the road test.**
- The new law changes the number of practice hours required during the permit phase, it changed from 30 hours to 50 hours. The DMV does not collect the practice driving record when teens go for their road test however they may ask to see it or the Road Ready app which also tracks practice time.

Your teen should work toward at least 100 hours of practice with 30 of those at night based on national recommendations put forth by AAA Foundation research in order to give novice drivers more experience before licensing (shows it reduces crashes after licensing). Our common goal for everyone is to have fewer crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving teens and all other drivers. Use of the Road Ready app is a great tool for them to track their progress of practice hours.

Who is eligible to enroll? Any student who is 14 years/10 months to 18 years old. Sign up information is located on the De Pere High School webpage under the "Students" tab under the Driver's Education link. Since 1980, the Holly Craft Faire has been held on the Saturday after Thanksgiving at the De Pere High School located at 1700 Chicago St., De Pere. We showcase over 200 booths of juried vendors presenting unique handmade items including painting, pottery, photography, woodworking, ornaments, iron garden designs, jewelry, handmade mittens, and much MUCH more. We are the largest craft faire of this type in the area! All vendors personally hand make all products for sale in their booths, hence why we are a jury show.

#### **ASVAB Test**

Are you looking to join the military after high school? If you answered yes, then the ASVAB is for you. The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a standardized test that helps determine a person's suitability for military service and their strengths in various areas to help them find a career that's a good fit. If you would like to take this test, please contact Assistant Principal, Mrs. Jeskie. She will provide you with more information.

#### **Work Permits**

Work Permits are required for all minors younger than 16. As of July 1, 2023 the Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division developed an online work permit application tool. The online application is available to the parents of minors 24-hours a day, 7-days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device.

**Permits are no longer done in person in the office**. Parents should go to the <u>dwd.wisconsin.gov</u> site to complete the work permit application and the \$10 work permit fee is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal. <u>Once the permit application process is complete</u>, the <u>Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer</u>.
