Board of Education Goals

Goal 1 Reading: Proficiency

The percentage of Grade 3 students who meet or exceed grade-level standards on the state English Language Arts SBAC assessment will grow from 48% in June 2023 to 70% by June 2028.

Goal 2 Reading: Acceleration

The percentage of students in Grades 4-8 scoring at the "Not Met" achievement level in the prior year who meet the scale score growth target on the state SBAC-English Language Arts assessment will increase from 28% in June 2023 to 60% in June 2028.

Goal 3 Algebra Proficiency

In pursuit of having more than 80% of Black/African American students meet the Algebra A-G requirement by the end of Grade 9, the proficiency gap between Black/African American students and all other students will decline from 5% in June 2023 to 0% by June 2028.

Goal 4 College & Career Readiness

In pursuit of having more than 66% of Black/African American graduating seniors A-G eligible, the proficiency gap between Black/African American students and all other students will decline from 15% in June 2023 to 0% by June 2028.


Board of Education Guardrails



Early on to Mid/Above Grade






- Emerging trends for **Grade 2** Diagnostic 1 placement



i-Ready D1 Placement for Prior Year SBAC "Not Met" Students



For Grades 4-8, 3 out of every 10 students scored "Not Met" on SBAC in 2023-24.

For these students, the placement on i-Ready overall was the same in D1 2024-25 as for the Not Met students in D1 of 2023-24.




i-Ready D1 Placement SBAC "Not Met" Students: Elementary

In 2024-25, Grade 4 had 4% fewer students 3+ grade levels below; there was no difference observed for Grade 5.




i-Ready D1 Placement for SBAC "Not Met" Students: Middle School

No differences were observed for **Middle School** grade levels in D1 placement comparing 2023-24 to 2024-25.




i-Ready D1 Placement Highlights for SBAC "Not Met" students

- Data was explored for positive outliers in Grades 4-5 across six Similar School groups
- 2 out of 6 groups showed a trend for reducing the placement of students in 3+ grade levels below
- 8 schools in the 2 groups reduced the percent of students 3+ grade levels below by an average of 8%, from 49% to 41%



Goals 1 & 2 Summary



D1 Placement

Overall, **D1 Placement** was similar to the prior year, with very slight decreases in rates of early on to mid/above grade level observed for Grades 1-3.



Monitoring Change

Current data provides a starting point for the year, however, monitoring changes in placement and growth at Diagnostic 2 will provide additional data on impacts of adult actions on student achievement and growth.



Progress over time

Additional study of "Not Met" students can provide insight into which students make up this group, with plans to analyze progress over time for Not-Met students.

Reference / Glossary

ELA - English Language Arts

FRSA - Foundational Reading Skills Assessment

District Assessment given to students in Grade TK to Grade 3 to assess their knowledge of foundational reading skills.

i-Ready

The i-Ready Diagnostic is an adaptive assessment that adjusts questions to suit students' needs.

The i-Ready Diagnostics are administered three times per year for students in grades 1 - 8 plus English Learners in Kindergarten & grades 9-12:

Diagnostic Windows 1, 2, & 3 (D1, D2, D3)

Assessments given at the start of the school year, mid-year, and during the Spring semester

Low SES - Low Socioeconomic Status

Students identified as receiving free-reduced price meals, foster youth, homeless students, students participating in the Migrant program, or students with parent education level less than high school graduate. Students would only be counted once, regardless of identification method.

SBAC - Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (pronounced "S-Back")

State Assessment given to students in Grade 3 to Grade 8 and Grade 11 to assess their knowledge of ELA and Math standards.
