

Dear Families:

The North Polk Community School District acknowledges the importance of the Minor School License (school permit) and approves the application for such license with the following guidelines:

1. The student and parent/guardian understand that said license is a privilege that will be revoked permanently if guidelines are not followed.
2. The student must have held a valid Instruction Permit during the six-month period immediately preceding this application.
3. The student's driving history must be free of convictions for moving traffic violations, contributive accidents, and license withdrawals during this six-month period.
4. HOURS: The student may only drive one hour prior and one hour following a school event. The Department of Transportation does not permit waivers or exceptions to this time stipulation.
5. ROUTE: The student must drive the MOST DIRECT AND ACCESSIBLE ROUTE between the student's home and the North Polk High School. The Minor School License may also be used to travel to and from extracurricular activities within the school district.

Please list your route by street name from your house to school. Do not draw a map. If there are two households, provide routes for both homes.

6. PASSENGERS: Passengers are allowed ONLY if they enter the vehicle at the student's home (licensee) and exit at the same destination as the driver. The same is true for the way home. No stops along the way to pick up or drop off passengers--you are not a school bus. There are restrictions on who can be a passenger.

Parents may choose not to allow passengers at any time.

7. FUEL: Stopping for fuel is allowed provided the service station is on the most direct and accessible route.
8. ELECTRONIC DEVICES: You may not at any time use an electronic device while driving on your school permit.
9. SAFETY: The student will use safe driving practices, particularly on and around any school facilities any inappropriate driving practices such as speeding, reckless driving, etc. will not be tolerated. The student will also abide by the parking assignment as established by the principal.

A school permit is a privilege. ***Any violations of the above guidelines may result in the forfeiture of the school license.*** By signing this agreement, we understand and accept the responsibilities of possessing a Minor School License for North Polk High School activities.
