# DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD



**LAURA ZIEGLER DAVIS '74**

After attending public school when she was young, Laura Ziegler Davis was delighted to matriculate to the all-girls environment of Sunset Hill School from whence she graduated in 1974. She then went to

Vassar College in Poughkeepsie, New York, earning a degree in anthropology.

Following college, she spent the next year as a research assistant at the relief and development agency Oxfam in Oxford, England. She also worked in a small clothing boutique and as a barmaid in one of the oldest pubs in Oxford, which she said may be the most fun job she ever had.

She returned to the States and worked as a reporter and news director with KCUR, the NPR affiliate in Kansas City. A few years later, she moved to Washington, D.C. to work as a producer at NPR for Weekend Edition Saturday with Scott Simon. Laura came back to Kansas City to marry her husband, Gardiner Davis, and work as a national reporter covering the Midwest for NPR. After their third child was born, she wanted to stick closer to home so she went back to the local station to work part time as a general assignment reporter and producer - creating the town-hall talk show Under the Clock, hosted by now-Congressman Emanuel Cleaver.

Now, as an editor and community engagement reporter, Laura works with a team to frame stories by listening to people and communities in different geographic or demographic groups. They seek to tell stories from an audience-first point of view, delving into what misperceptions the media has and how better to authentically cover their population.

After so many years as a reporter and producer, Laura is excited to be practicing journalism in this untraditional way. When not working, she also loves to spend time with her three (now grown) children and family, travel, garden, take in Kansas City's vast cultural amenities, read and be outdoors.



**DON HALL JR., '74**  
**Executive Chairman –**

Donald J. Hall, Jr. is executive chairman of Hallmark Cards, Inc., a Kansas City, Mo.-based company known throughout the world for its greeting cards and personal expression products; television programming through Hallmark Media and Hallmark Hall of Fame productions; as well as Crayola, a company that inspires creativity in children through crayons and other innovative art tools, crafting activities and toys. Hall also serves as chairman of the Hallmark board of directors.

Hall is the third generation of the Hall family to lead this privately held business, which was founded in 1910 by his grandfather, J.C. Hall.

Hall joined the company in 1971, working in multiple areas of the business – from manufacturing and sales, to product development and creative – before taking over the company's top position in 2002.

Hall is active in the Kansas City community as a member of the MRIGlobal Board of Trustees, University of Kansas School of Business Board of Advisors, Children's Mercy Research Institute Advisory Council, the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art Board of Trustees, the Kansas City Civic Council. He served on the National Board of Trustees of The John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.

# ALUMNI SERVICE AWARD



## **JERRY WOODS '69**

Gerald Milton Woods received his work ethic and passion for education and service to others from his parents. Jerry attended DA Holmes elementary school and was one of the first two Black students to attend Pembroke-Country Day School, where he excelled in sports and academics and graduated in the top five of his class.

He attended Princeton University where his senior thesis was on the topic of sickle cell anemia. His clinical excellence, compassion and duty to service was recognized during the time he was a student at Duke University School of Medicine. Following medical school, he returned to Kansas City and as a pediatric resident at Children's Mercy between 1976 and 1978, he was known for being committed to his patients, professional and academically oriented. Following a fellowship in pediatric hematology-oncology at Duke, Dr. Woods served three years at Wright Patterson AFB medical center ultimately achieving the rank of major. His first academic assignment was

at Dayton Children's Hospital, where he set up their sickle cell clinic. Dr. Woods came back to Kansas City, joining Children's Mercy in 1983, and quickly catapulted to leader status in the section of hematology and oncology, becoming the director of the Sickle Cell Program in 1983, director of the hematology-oncology fellowship program in 1984, acting chief of the section in 1986 and division director in 1994.

He was promoted to associate professor at the University of Missouri-Kansas City School of Medicine in 1987 and to professor in 1992. His more than 50 publications generated over 4,000 citations and includes his groundbreaking research published in the New England Journal of Medicine that confirmed the lifesaving impact of oral penicillin prophylaxis for children with sickle cell anemia. This was followed by many other articles in high impact journals identifying best practices for children with cancer or hemoglobinopathies. An innovator in care of children, he was the founder and director of the Sickle Cell Camp (Camp Courage), for more than three decades.

While retiring from Children's Mercy, Dr. Woods continues as the course director of Fundamentals in Medicine as faculty at the SOM in the Department of Medical Humanities and Bioethics. He is a dedicated father, husband, grandfather and friend, an incredible physician leader, who teaches and mentors with integrity and professionalism, inspiring students, staff and patients.

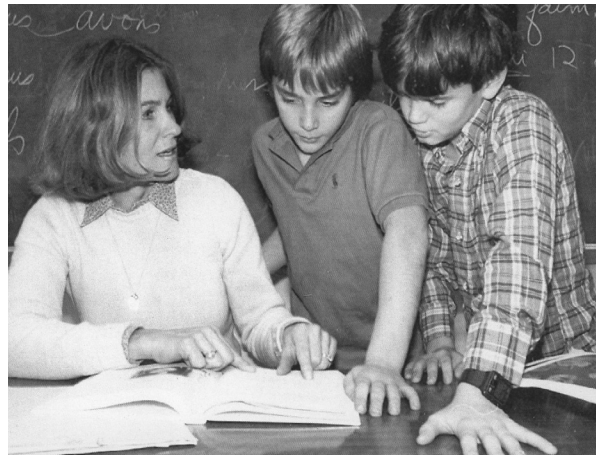
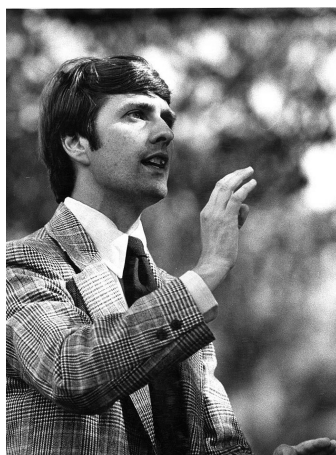

# HALL OF FAME

Pembroke Hill School and its predecessor schools—Sunset Hill School and Pembroke-Country Day School (Pem-Day)—have been shaped by dedicated faculty and staff. As a way to honor those who have made a significant impact on students’ lives, the Pem-Day Class of 1949 established the Pembroke Hill Faculty and Staff Hall of Fame in 1989. Faculty and staff who have dedicated 25 years of service to the school are recognized.

Please join us to celebrate the extraordinary life of Faculty and Staff Hall of Fame Member and Former Boys and Girls Tennis **Coach Dale Eshelbrenner** and to honor the entire **Boys Tennis Program** both of whom were inducted into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame in May 2024.

Established over 70 years ago, the Pembroke Hill School (formerly Pembroke-Country Day) boys tennis program has consistently showcased excellence on the court. The boys tennis program's outstanding achievements, including 24 state titles and 43 appearances at the Missouri State High School Activities Association's Boys Tennis State Championships, mark a historic legacy in the state's sports history. Six singles players won nine titles and 14 doubles teams have clinched state championships, setting a standard of performance unparalleled in Missouri's tennis landscape.

"We are immensely proud of the accomplishments of our boys tennis program," said Brad Shelley, head of school. "The dedication, skill and sportsmanship of students past and present have not only brought great success to our

school, but have also inspired generations of student-athletes."

The late Dale Eshelbrenner, beloved head coach of the boys and girls tennis program, was posthumously inducted into the Missouri State Hall of Fame. Eshelbrenner, who passed away in August 2016, guided the boys tennis team to 13 of its 24 state titles during his 25 years as head boys tennis coach (1991-2016). He also led the girls team for 22 years (1992-2014), earning seven state titles. His boys and girls programs won a combined 10 singles titles and 11 doubles titles during his tenure as head coach, solidifying his status as a legendary figure within the Missouri tennis community.

"Dale Eshelbrenner's legacy transcends mere victories," remarked Pembroke Hill's athletic director Amanda Lehotak. "His impact on our student-athletes extended far beyond the tennis court, shaping character and instilling values that endure to this day." We will also celebrate the (nine) Girls Tennis Championships several of which were won under Coach Eshelbrenner.

third grade to seeing them at the top of their game as seniors and beyond."

Avery wishes to thank the hundreds of players she has coached throughout the years, the many coaches she's worked with, the many supportive parents who have added to the success of the program and the school's support for field hockey. "I know field hockey will continue to thrive at Pembroke Hill, and I look forward to cheering on the future teams and celebrating their successes."
