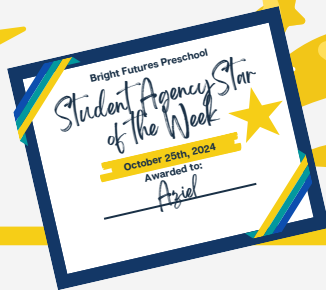

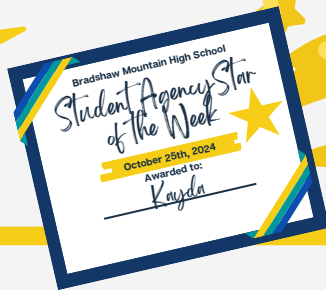

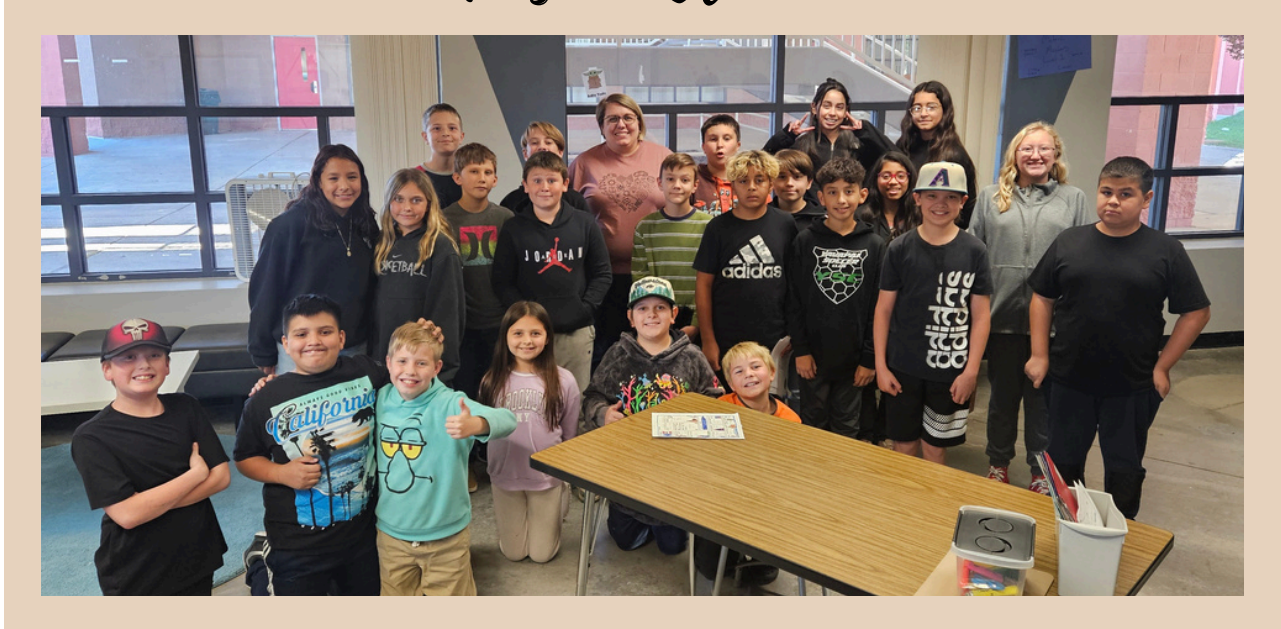




PROJECT MOMENTUM TRAILBLAZER SPOTLIGHT

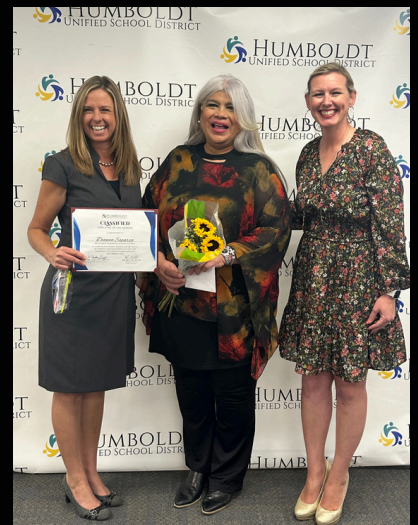

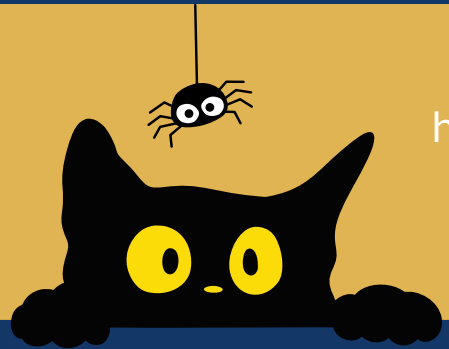


Liberty Traditional School has enjoyed a fantastic and successful season in both Middle school volleyball and 7th & 8th grade cross country!
