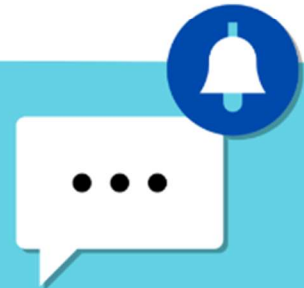
Kyrene School District and your child's school want to keep you informed of important news and events.



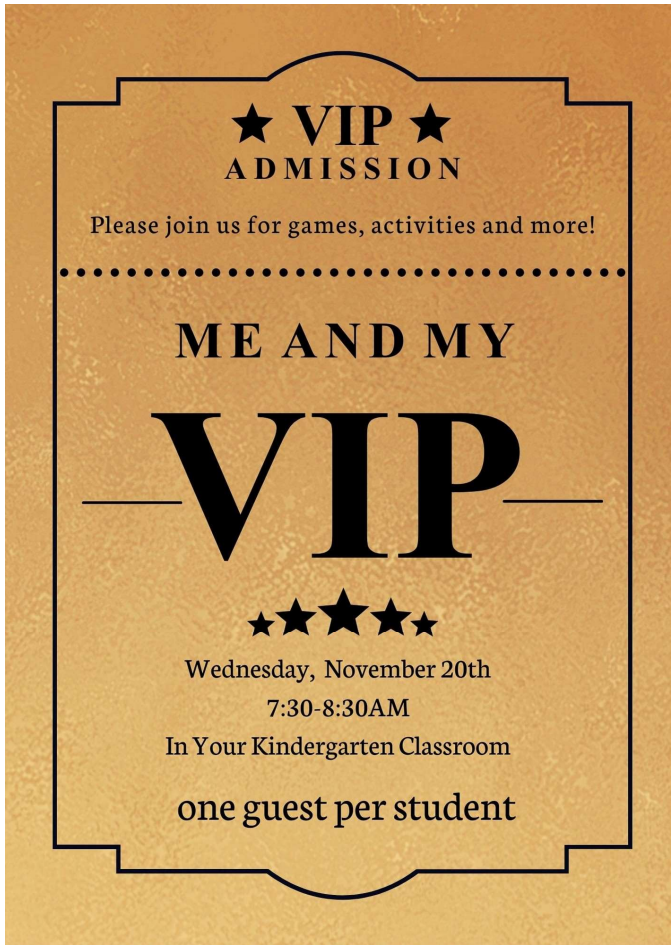

We are planning to do our warm-ups and the Chicken Dance with Mrs. Levy. Meet us under the blue ramada next to the KMS tennis courts. All students from Waggoner and relatives who wish to participate with the students will jog around the identified route on the KMS track and Waggoner fields. Our students have been working hard to improve their **CARDIO RESPIRATORY ENDURANCE** in P.E. in preparation for the Turkey Trot. The course will be a ½ mile for K-3 and ¾ mile for 4th and 5th. Parents, grandparents, and relatives who will not be jogging with us are welcome to stand along the course and cheer on all the participants or wait at the finish line by the balloon arch.
