Central High School (Central) offers a range of alternative programs in the Morgan Hill Unified School District from in person learning to online coursework via Edmentum and CyberHigh for the Independent Study Program. Central Grading System:

Students enrolled in Central's core program earn 2.5 credits per course each marking period, based on the following grading scale: A (100-90%), B (89-80%), C (79-70%), D (69-60%), and F (below 59%). Central High School conducts a six-period schedule with new grading periods every six weeks. Students have an opportunity to complete credits every six weeks.

Independent Study/Edmentum Grading System:

Students enrolled in the Independent Study Program hosted via Central take a-g course via Edmentum Courseware earn 5 credits per course on the following grading scale: A (100-90%), B (89-80%), C (79-70%), D (69-60%), and F (below 59).
