



## STUDENT BILL OF RIGHTS

We, the Board of Education, in collaboration with student board members of the Orange Unified School District, believe all students have the right to a free and appropriate public education. With this right comes each student's responsibility to attend school with a positive attitude toward learning and respect for the dignity of the educational system. To this end, the Board of Education hereby establishes the following student Bill of Rights.

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The right to state standard curriculum and to learn at a level and pace appropriate to each student's ability.

The right to excel with the support of the school community, which includes but is not limited to teachers, counselors, and coaches.

The right to gain skills that will enable students to be college and career-ready.

The right to retain individuality within the limitations and boundaries of the school policies.

The right to be treated with dignity.

The right to embrace one's ethnic, cultural, and social background.

The right to a safe environment.

The right to safe and clean facilities.

The right to participate in additional educational opportunities

The right to provide feedback through various student voice platforms.
