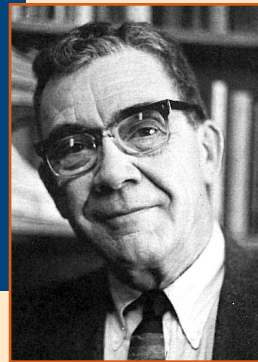

He began teaching at Gow in 1931 and served as Gow's second Headmaster from 1955-1976. What a legacy!
