ASSIGNMENTS DURING ABSENCES

If a student is absent for minor illness or medical issue, we do expect students to continue to stay current on their assignments and any assessments that are permitted to be done from home. When absent, students should email their teachers <u>and</u> check their Google Classroom accounts daily. **A parent or guardian must call the school attendance office (937-653-1414) before 9:00 a.m. to report student absences.**

STUDENT FEES

Students may pay school fees in the main office during lunch or after school. Fees can also be paid through the website under Quick Links (A-H), choose Fee Payments and then follow the prompts. Grade cards will be held and course credit cannot be certified until fees have been paid. Students will also not be allowed to attend school dances or receive a work permit until fees are paid or a payment plan is arranged. Fees are required to be paid in full to attend Prom and to participate in the graduation ceremony.

ARRIVAL AND BREAKFAST

Students who do not use bus transportation or do not participate in the school-wide free breakfast program should not arrive until 7:25 a.m. Students should enter through door 1 or 13 and report directly to their first period class or homeroom. Students arriving by bus or participating in the free breakfast for all program should arrive between 7:00 a.m. and 7:25 a.m.

FREE AND REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONAL FEES

Please make sure you have completed and returned the Free and Reduced-Price School Meals Application for your student. During the 2024-2025 school year, Ohio Revised Code 3313.642 prohibits districts from charging instructional fees for those eligible for <u>free</u> lunch through this program. To receive the instructional fee waiver, the Sharing Information with other Programs Form must be completed and returned.

Mobile Response and Stabilization Services – New Support Services for UHS! MRSS was created by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services for the goal of supplementing, rather than replacing crisis related programming for children presenting to emergency rooms and crisis support lines. MRSS provides behavioral health stabilization counseling, case management, and peer support services in the home, school, and community for up to 42 days. MRSS is for children and families ages 0-21. Primary Goals of MRSS are:

-Reducing use of emergency departments or acute care services.

-Prevent out-of-home placements which includes residential and group home care.

-Decrease involvement with Children Services or Juvenile Justice Systems.

-Empower Youth and Families to implement their own individualized crisis plan.
