PEARLAND, TEXAS was established in 1894 and is one of the fastest growing suburbs of Houston, located approximately 15 miles south of downtown Houston, in northern Brazoria County. The city is home to nearly 133,000 residents. With Pearland Independent School District serving more than 21,000 students attending 23 campuses.

TURNER COLLEGE AND CAREER HIGH SCHOOL was established in 2013 in memory of the late Robert Turner former Pearland ISD Superintendent from 1968-1978. The school currently serves 1120 students (303 in 9th grade, 286 in 10th grade, 280 in 11th grade, 288 in 12th grade), comprised of 34% Caucasian, 10% African American, 44% Hispanic, 9% Asian and 2% Multi-Racial or Other.

- See the 2024-2025 Pearland ISD Course Catalog to be released in February for details. Dual Credit will receive weighted credit at the Honors level of 5.0.
- Dual Credit is real college credit on a real college transcript.
- The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board ensures that this core academic dual credit will transfer to state colleges and universities in Texas.
- We find this credit is also honored in many private universities and out-of-state schools.
- College admissions counselors often consider the college transcript in addition to the high school transcript when a student applies for admissions with more than 40 credit hours.

College Savings

The associate degree (60 credit hours or equivalent to two years of college) is approximately \$3440 in tuition and fees and \$2000 in books.








The Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS) is a voluntary, co-operative effort among 134 Texas community colleges and universities to facilitate transfer of freshman and sophomore level general academic coursework. TCCNS provides a shared, uniform set of course designations for students and their advisors to use in determining both course

Check Course Compatibility

The Texas Common Course Numbering System provides its users three different ways of traversing through the common co matrix. Searching by institution allows users to view a single institution's compatible courses. Comparing institutions allows users to select two institutions at a time to check against the entire current common course matrix.
