School Board Seeking Representative for KCPS Retirement System Board of Trustees

The Kansas City Public Schools (KCPS) Board of Directors is now accepting applications for a representative to serve on the KCPS Retirement System Board of Trustees. This four-year term begins on January 1, 2025, and ends in December 2029.

The appointed representative will be selected by the KCPS Board of Directors under the provisions of Section 169.291, subsection 1 of the Missouri Revised Statutes, which mandates that KCPS Board appointees to the KCPSRS Board be resident taxpayers of the school district. The role of the KCPSRS Board of Trustees is to oversee the administration and governance of the retirement system, safeguard fund assets, and foster open communication between the Board and management while establishing policies and monitoring performance.

Trustees are expected to serve as fiduciaries, regularly attend Board meetings (held monthly from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. on the first Monday of each month) and complete a minimum of six hours of Board education each year.
