What is EDI?

- EDI is **Extended Day Instruction**
- Used to provide remedial and academic enrichment opportunities outside of the school day
- Most programs are offered after school for 1 hr
- Funded through our Title IV federal grant
- Programs are free
- Bus transportation and snack is provided after school

Elementary



- EDI opportunities offered
 - **Academic support:** Engaging activities that reinforce social skills, confidence, and academic success in literacy, mathematics and STEM. (*offered Tuesdays - Thursdays for 1 hr*)
 - **Legacy Maker Academy:** Offers a rotating schedule of enrichment activities, including coding, culinary, and music. Sessions will be designed to ignite curiosity, develop skills, and spark joy in learning through hands-on exploration. (*dates TBD*)

Middle School

- EDI opportunities offered
 - **Extended Day Walk-In Support:** Provides flexible, drop-in assistance in all content areas (*offered Mondays - Thursdays from 2:30 to 3:30 PM*)
 - **Language Bridge:** Available for scholars classified as Entering or Emerging ENL. This program offers a blend of Language Acquisition, Home Language Arts, and Bilingual Math Instruction, providing targeted support to help scholars strengthen their language and academic skills in a bilingual setting (*offered Mondays - Thursdays from 2:30 to 3:30 PM*)
 - **Targeted Learning Academies:** Provides additional, individualized support in Mathematics and Reading for qualifying scholars. Based on MAP assessment scores, selected scholars will receive invitations to the academy that best meets their needs. Academies provide two days of Reading targeted instruction and two days of Math targeted instruction each week (*offered Mondays - Thursdays from 2:30 to 3:30 PM*)
 - **Regents Prep:** Scholars are provided with Regents based tutoring in preparation for Living Environment and Algebra (*dates vary*)
 - **Pre-Accelerated Prep:** Helps prepare scholars for entrance into the accelerated pathway. These sessions will focus on essential prerequisite skills and concepts with select scholars (*dates vary*)

High School

- EDI opportunities offered
 - **Homework Help:** Content area instructors are available in the Upper Collab Space to provide support with homework, organization, and general review.
 - **Content Specific Regents Support:** Scholars are provided with Regents based tutoring to support them passing the January and June Regents for: Algebra I/Bilingual Algebra I, Biology/Bilingual Biology, Physics, Bilingual ELA, ELA, Global History, and US History.
 - **Science Lab Make-up-** Scholars are required by the state to acquire lab minutes in order to sit for the Regents. This program begins December 4th for Earth Science and Biology.
 - **Seal of Civic Readiness:** Scholars who are earning the Seal through the pathway option can work on their documentation with the support of educators (*offered Wednesdays for 1 hour*).
 - **College Applications Camp:** Support with college applications and personal statement / college essay (*offered Tuesdays & Thursdays for 1 hour*).
 - **Social Studies Learning Experiences:** Fun and engaging learning experiences to increase background knowledge and improve reading comprehension (*dates vary*).
 - **Language Bridge:** Scholars receive support from an ENL educator who helps to strengthen their speaking and listening language skills. Scholars also build their confidence through targeted language development and academic assistance (*offered Mondays - Thursdays for 1 hour*).
