

CCMS HOOPERS SPLIT TWIN BILL WITH DYERSBURG; HOME AGAIN ON THURSDAY

Jeremiah Young outscored Dyersburg's entire team 9-6 in the first half and Will Dodds scored all eight of his points in the final two quarters as Coach Tyler Gadlen's Crockett County Middle School boys posted a 29-20 basketball victory over the visiting Trojans Monday night.

Young finished with a team-high 13 points as the Cavaliers improved their season record to 4-1. Davis Porter added five points for Crockett and made the team's lone three-pointer. The Cavs held Dyersburg scoreless in the entire second quarter on their way to a 16-6 halftime advantage.

In the girls contest that opened Monday night's doubleheader, Dyersburg raced to a 24-13 halftime advantage and withstood a second-half rally by the Lady Cavs to record a 42-34 triumph behind the 18-point scoring of Desleigh Strayhorn - 10 of them from the free throw line.

Ruth Gourley led Crockett with 14 points and Jentry Maddox added 12 as Coach Jamar Turner's squad fell to 2-3 on the season. Addie Whitby tallied six points for the Lady Cavs.

CCMS will host Union City in a 6:00 twin bill Thursday night.
