This scholarship fund is sponsored by Roberts-McMillen Post 332 Sons of the American Legion and the Damascus Township Fire Department and by contributions of family, friends and the community.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a resident of the McClure Village/Damascus Township Fire Department Area.

Recommended that applicants be accepted to a College, University or Trade School and a letter stating such be enclosed.

The scholarship may be used for academic, technical or vocational training at the post high school level.

The scholarship may be used for full or part time programs.

The desire to exceed and the will to achieve that goal should be a priority.

The scholarship committee shall make the final choices to receive the scholarship.

The receipt of payment to the educational institution is required and mailed to the person in the enclosed envelope.

An applicant may apply yearly, as long as he/she continues a post high school education (this scholarship is for four years only) and as the other requirements are met.

Each applicant must write an essay of not more than 200 words why he/she should be considered for this scholarship.

Applications may be picked up at McClure Library - Mon (1-6), Tue (1-6), Thurs (1-6), Sat (9-12), Napoleon High School, Patrick Henry High School, Liberty Center High School, Otsego High School.
