Catholic Grade School Educators Scholarship

Criteria

Applicant must be a full time educator in a Portland-metropolitan Catholic elementary school for three consecutive years. Eligible educators include classroom teachers, administrators and development directors only.*

Terms & Conditions

- Application and verification must be successfully completed each year, including principal verification and signature.
- Candidate must complete the FACTS application each year. **
- Discount is limited to one student per family. Additional financial assistance may be available through the financial aid process. Families with multiple La Salle students will be considered for additional financial assistance upon completion of the FACTS application.
- Changes in employment status must be communicated to La Salle's Business Office no later than the end of the semester in which the conditions of scholarship criteria are no longer met.
- This discount is offered to ensure qualified Catholic educators receive a reduction in tuition equal to 50%. Any additional financial assistance, such as need-based financial aid, merit scholarships, or outside scholarships will be factored into the discount calculation to ensure the total cumulative award balance is equal to 50% of tuition.
- All deadlines for applications must be met each year to qualify for the discount.

** Due to resource limitations, part time employees and support staff positions are not eligible for the discount but are encouraged to apply for financial aid by completing the FACTS application.*

***The financial data provided by the FACTS application is used to assess our success in delivering on the mission and spirit of the Partners in Education program. The discount is not contingent on the data provided through the FACTS application.*
