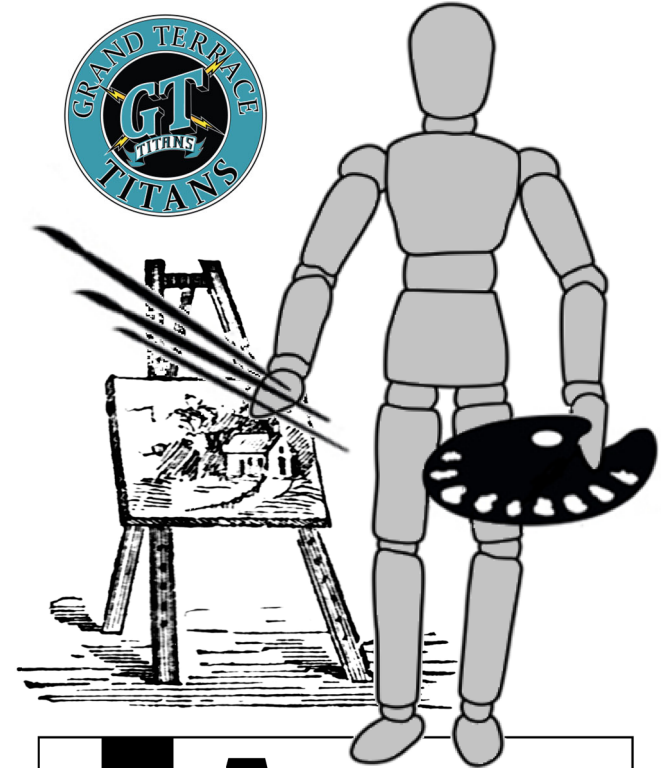

Academy students are expected to commit to the four-year pathway track focusing their studies in visual arts.
