

INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

It is the policy of the Governor Wentworth Regional School Board that instruction be aligned with the vision, mission, and goals of the District, as well as the rules of the New Hampshire Education Department.

Instruction will be focused on meeting the instructional needs of students with varied talents, interests, and development.

The instructional program will include:

1. Procedures for diagnosing learner needs;
2. Methods and strategies for teaching that incorporate learner needs;
3. Techniques for the evaluation of student outcomes; and

All instruction will reflect the acknowledgment of diversity and respect for differences.

Instruction will also include, where possible, consideration of available resources, including but not limited to organization, businesses, talented individuals, natural resources, and technology to engage each student in achieving the necessary skill and knowledge.

Students will be encouraged to participate in year-round learning.
