- 130 credits will be earned in the required subject areas, 25 electives.
- Students must complete and present the Student Portfolio (elective credits).
- Students must earn 20 credits in residency at Stein.

20 credits - Science (Biology & Physical Science)

20 credits - Math (including Algebra 1)

10 credits - Fine Arts

25 credits - Electives (including Physical Education)
