SCHOOL/STUDENT BODY

Established in 1963, American International School-Riyadh (AIS-R) is a non-profit, co-ed K-12 school, which is fully accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges and the Council of International Schools. AIS-R's campus is located in Riyadh, the capital city of Saudi Arabia. The purpose-built campus includes Elementary, Middle and High School classrooms, gymnasiums, theaters, all weather track and field, tennis courts, Learning Commons, computer labs and Makerspaces. AIS-R operates under the authorization of the Ministry of Education and is an IBDP World School.



CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAM

All High School students participate in Global Citizenship Learning, Service Learning, membership of clubs, Advisory sessions, assemblies, and Week Without Walls. All students are encouraged to try out for our competitive sports program including swimming, golf, basketball, soccer, track and field, cross country, badminton, volleyball, wrestling, and table tennis teams. In

addition, all students take an online Eagle Citizenship Course which explores Academic Integrity, Digital Citizenship, ePortfolio curation, and student self-management skills.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

AIS-R provides a college preparatory educational program in the English language and offers both the U.S. High School Diploma and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (DP). All Grade 11 and Grade 12 students take internal examinations and students in DP courses sit for external examinations. AIS-R's school year consists of two semesters beginning in August and ending in June. Students enroll in a maximum of eight courses using a 4 X 4 block schedule. One-half credit is awarded for the successful completion of each semester course with a passing mark of 2 out of 7. A minimum of 25 credits is required for graduation, and students are encouraged to participate in community service every year at AIS-R. AIS-R teachers are licensed and certified to instruct in all U.S. Diploma courses and IBDP courses.








World Average Percentage


RANK AND GPA POLICY
