Insurance: Medicaid and most other private insurance (Medicaid will cover inpatient but patient will need to meet stricter requirements for coverage)

Levels/types of care: Inpatient (5-7 days & need to qualify after an assessment is done), Partial Hospitalization (PHP), and Intensive Outpatient (IOP)

Conditions treated: Substance Abuse, Mental health, Co-occurring disorders.

Details: Ages 12-18 "The first step is to come to one of our facilities for a comprehensive mental health assessment. Assessments can be scheduled by phone or chat, anytime day or night.

Following the assessment, our team will work with your child and family to determine the best approach to treatment."

Levels/types of care: Acute Inpatient (usually 3-5 days), Partial Hospitalization (PHP) and Intensive Outpatient (IOP) Program

Conditions treated: suicidal ideation, homicidal ideation, and/or psychotic features, various mental health diagnoses (substance abuse is not the main diagnoses they treat)

Details: Ages 13-17 – they provide no-cost mental health assessments
