

These independent learning tasks should be completed by 13.12.2024. Pupils are expected to complete all tasks. All completed tasks will be rewarded with positive points.

**Reading:** Pupils in years 4 to 6 follow the Reading Eggs programme and should be completing this 5 times a week for 20 minutes, working through the levels and maps, along with completing the weekly assignments set by their teacher. Pupils should access the library area of the programme in addition to this and read a variety of books. Please contact your child's teacher if you need a reminder of your child's login details.

**Mathematics and numeracy**

Write some maths questions for Mr Smith or Mrs Davies to answer. They need to be based on the work that we have done in year 4 so far. So questions based on place value, adding and subtracting, length and perimeter.  
Alternatively, write 5 questions to test your classmates knowledge! You will need to know the answer though!

**English, literacy and communication**

Draw a wanted poster for the arrest of Frankenstein. Make sure that you write warnings about him eg he is dangerous etc, descriptions eg he is nine foot tall etc and comment on what he is wanted for eg the murders etc.

**Science and technology**

Independent learning task sheet has been uploaded onto the Google Classroom. For each row you complete you get an added two points to your total points which links to the leadership board. All work needs to be uploaded to the drive or handed in to Mrs Francis.

Research the work of Mary Seacole and what she did to fight disease. With the information you have found out, make a poster and bring into school - or create a Google slide and submit it on classroom.
