**Just a few reminders and updates:**

### **Lunch Drop-Offs & Forgotten Items**

At Cleveland, we take every measure we can to protect instructional time during the school day. In an effort to limit classroom disruptions, we continue to implement the policy to not interrupt instructional time to call classrooms due to forgotten items or lunches.

The office cannot interrupt instructional time to have students pick up food in the office. We ask parents to limit food drop offs. We understand that there will be special circumstances or occasions when it is absolutely necessary to do so. On these occasions, we ask that you make arrangements with your child so they are aware food will be dropped off, and know to pick up their food at lunch time. Please let your student know that they are not allowed to share their food with others, and to make sure to throw their trash away.
