




## **Empowering** Excellence

### **Turning Passion to Purpose**

Growing up in a small town in Central Java, and passionate about the ways in which science and engineering can change lives, Sakti is determined to use his scholarship opportunity to help others.

"I always wanted to be able to develop my hometown, but I didn't really understand what I could do to help or to take action. During my time at JIS, there were so many great teachers who inspired me to take concrete action on how to develop myself, the environment, and communities, and to advocate for them.

It's important for me that my ideas and actions are more impactful to my surroundings, so right now I'm working on a project to improve the mobility of the people in my hometown through my studies in transportation systems and connectivity.

And I'm also working on several other things that could help social issues in my hometown, such as the lack of high-quality education and child marriage."

## 10 Years Strengthening Ties With Indonesia Through Service

Since its inception, JIS Peduli has been empowering students to take initiative and make a meaningful difference in the local community. JIS Peduli collaborates with over 30 service organizations through various student-led clubs, and many of them are trusted, long-term partners.

In 2023/24, funding from JIS Peduli enabled our Middle and High School students to offer a range of activities every week (including robotics, sports, and arts) to hundreds of local students. Additionally, it supported International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma students with Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) projects and provided transport for hundreds of service outreach activities in our community.

## 2023/24 Highlights



The Battery Recycling Program collaborated with a local partner to set up battery recycling bins on campus. Students collect used batteries, which are then disposed of responsibly to further the school's sustainability goals.



Power of the Pen provided financial support to six Indonesian women pursuing higher education in music, technology, and medicine. In turn, these scholars worked closely with our students to create a rich and mutually beneficial learning experience.



A Place to Call Home supported after-school programs in a local kampung with materials for music and sports. JIS students organized and led activities, creating new opportunities for local students.

**Building a Brighter Future** by Empowering Professional **Development in Jakarta** 

The Innovative Schools Programme (ISP) was established in 2013 by JIS Alumnus Emmanuel Laumonier to enhance the teaching skills of public school elementary educators. The program aims to improve the educational experiences of students in Indonesia with support and resources provided by the ISP network, which includes JIS, Mentari Intercultural School, and Beacon Academy.

JIS faculty members volunteer their time to facilitate the nine-monthlong series of workshops, conducted in Bahasa Indonesia at JIS. The six-hour training sessions supported by translators take place over 10 weekends throughout the year. The workshops cover essential topics such as building positive classroom relationships, behavior management, designing engaging curricula, and developing instructional strategies.

The ISP workshops are part of a larger community effort aimed at supporting local educators and improving the quality of public education. At the end of the program, participants are assessed on a portfolio they present to demonstrate how they have implemented their learning for impact.


## Ivonne Bojoh (Class of 1992)
