SUICIDE THREAT/IDEATION: IMMEDIATE ATTENTION: Services are offered at the hospital's emergency room (Phoebe Putney) –At check in parent **MUST** indicate their child has mentioned suicidal threat/ideation (thoughts). They need immediate assessment and need to be evaluated.
